In a year of drought it is hard to remember that in normal seasons there are usually many million-dollar rains, that is, torrential downpours which carry tons of top soil off the farms into the streams and rivers. In some especially rainy years the annual loss is reckoned in millions of tons of good farming land which eventually is carried out to sea. This unhampered erosion is largely due to the denuding of forests at the headwaters of streams, and too, the farmers generally have done little to prevent heavy washouts in their own fields. The money loss is said to reach \$200,000,000 a year.—Exchange

Housewives Quickly Note Missing Item in Modernly Equipped Kitchen



A telephone which attracted a lot of attention on the opening day of A Century of Progress Exposition at Chicago did so because it wasn't there!

The absence of the telephone was due to a series of last-minute circumstances; and it was thought at the time that no one would notice it. But those who were in charge of the H. J. Heinz Company's exhibit at the Exposition didn't know the American housewife of today as well as they thought they did.

Colored instrument installed
The exhibit showed a series of replicas of kitchens in other lands and in earlier times, contrasted with the attractive and well-equipped kitchen of 1933. As originally featured, this kitchen contained a conveniently located extension telephone of special color to harmonize with the decorative scheme of the room. But within an hour of the opening of the exhibit, the telephone mysteriously disappeared. Someone had "lifted" it, and there wasn't sufficient time to procure another instrument of exactly

the right shade. Rather than to make use of a black telephone, even temporarily, it was decided to wait for a new instrument of the proper color, it being figured out that with so much to see, especially on the opening day, the absence of the telephone would hardly be noticed.

However, such proved to be far from the case. Before the substitute instrument arrived there was a flood of comments and inquiries, "Your modern kitchen certainly looks complete — except that it should have an extension telephone," commented one alert housewife. "Would not a telephone be convenient in a kitchen of 1933?" asked another. "You have a radio but no telephone!" objected a third. And there were dozens and scores of others who asked, bluntly, "Where's the telephone?" The number and frequency of the inquiries were convincing evidence that, whatever may be the things one may safely omit from a modern kitchen, the telephone is not one of them.
