### ADDITIONS BRING CWA TOTAL AT WORK TO 129

total of men at work, jumping the number from 25 to 60. Of the 35 additional men put to work, 20 had been added up to Thursday and 15 more were scheduled to begin on Friday morning.

Practically all of the 35 new men are unemployed, the first 25 all having been on welfare rolls for men. A new foreman has been engaged, C. W. Rankin of Pontiac, directing the work under the general supervision of William Gregor.

All of the men are working on the Farmington Road sewer project, and will continue on it until it is completed. The men are rotated to give each the standard number of working hours.

The men have plunged into the work in high spirits and enthusiasm, revealing great satisfaction at being again on a payroll rather than suffering idleness and being forced to accept charity. All have expressed much gratitude for the chance to work, and those in charge say that the men have indicated by their energy and willingness to work that they are worthy of the opportunity—that "they are good workers."

The men have publicly expressed their gratitude to Harold Grace, welfare investigator in Farmington City, for his activity in seeing that they are provided with over-shoes and other clothing appropriate for their work. He has kept in close touch with the situation and endeavored to see that every man was properly outfitted for his job.

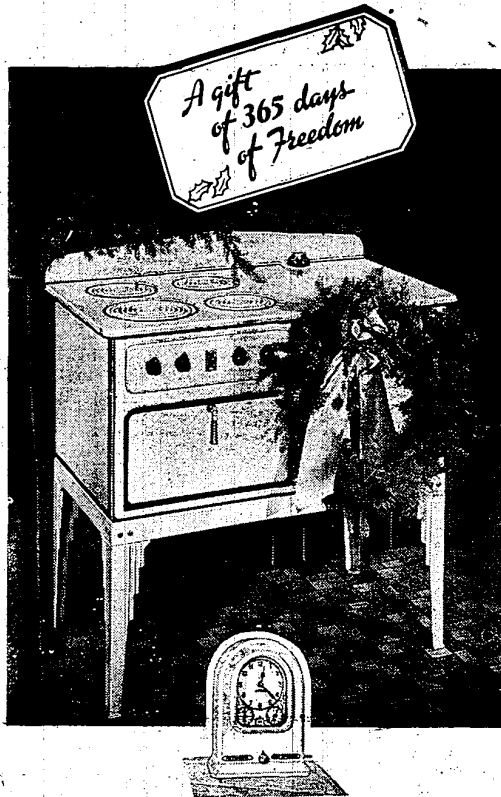
