 montary proof of such service must be submitted with the application.
 Residence—Applicants for this examination must have actually resided within the delivery of the vacancy office for one year immediately preceding the closing date for receipt of applications.
 Applications—Form "10" and Form 2223, containing full information as to the requirements to be met, and the character of the examination to be given may be obtained from any one of the vacancy offices listed or from the United States Civil Service Commission, Washington, D. C. Applications must be properly executed showing the examination point at which the applicant desires to be examined and must be filed with the Commission at Washington prior to the close of business on the date specified at the head of the announcement.
 The Post-Office department will not appoint to the position of postmaster any of the following: (a) The husband or wife of a rural carrier; (b) a person concerned in a contract for carrying the mails, either as contractor, sub-contractor, or surety, nor any member of his immediate family.
 Warning—All persons are warned against offering, promising, paying, soliciting, or receiving any money or other valuable thing as a political contribution or otherwise for use of influence, support, or promise of support in obtaining appointment. Any such act is a violation of law, and offenders will be prosecuted.

Parrot Learns 126 Words in 7 Years

John Tio is a remarkable parrot. Not only has he a vocabulary of 126 words, acquired during seven years of training, but he recently made use of one of science's newest inventions in order to demonstrate his linguistic prowess to an audience.
 John Tio plays his part in a display of curiosities from all over the world assembled by Robert L. Ripley of "Believe It or Not" fame. The parrot's words are many, but his voice needs a loud speaker to make it audible in a theater. Not long ago John Tio was scheduled to appear at the Palace Theater in Indianapolis. Twenty minutes before the rise

 of the curtain, it was discovered that the theater's sound amplifying equipment was out of order.
 In this emergency, the theater manager appealed to the Indiana Bell Telephone Company. In fifteen minutes a portable amplifier set had been brought to the theater and installed back-stage. To it was connected a lapel microphone, about the size of a quarter, which has been developed by the Bell Telephone Laboratories. When the curtain rose, this miniature microphone was in the lapel buttonhole of John Tio's master, who held the parrot on his hand. From the loud speaker issued John Tio's 126 words.

Destruction of Pompeii
 Pompeii was partly destroyed by an earthquake in 63 A. D. and, after having been rebuilt, was totally destroyed again by an eruption from Vesuvius in 79 A. D., when approximately 2,000 inhabitants perished. It was not until 1748 that the theater, the amphitheater and other portions of the town were laid bare. Since 1860 the Italian government has prosecuted the work of excavation and visitors are conducted through streets which contain ruins made by vehicles 2,000 years ago, shops and houses, many of which contain their original decorations.
