Images from five slide film and movie projectors will converge on a 30-foot screen in a graphic presentation of audio-visual techniques in St. Bernardine Catholic Church in Westland at 8:30 p.m. Friday, Dec. 10.

They will be shown by Pat Mardney, Oakland County director of audio visual education and second speaker in the St. Bernardine adult speakers forum.

His topic will be "First the Word—Then the Show."

The group will see the steel plant and automotive assembly line, lunch at the Ford Museum cafeteria and then browse through the museum and view craft demonstrations.

MRS. ARTHUR SCHAN, secretary of the Stevenson High School adult AFS chapter, and Mrs. William Bollin, president of the Bentley High adult group, will go along on the tour as sponsors.

The AFS visitors joining the outing include Bentley students Melika Ben Ammar, whose home is in Tunisia, and Franz Bernhard Esink of Germany. Also on the tour will be Enrico Gino Jr. from the Philippines, a student at Stevenson this year, and

Patricia Gomez of Chili, who is Churchill High School's first AFS exchange student.

Mrs. E.L. Cooper of Birmingham is in charge of arrangements for the trip, the second of three planned for Michigan AFS students by the Detroit Metropolitan board.

In October the board sponsored a bus trip to Lansing where the foreign students viewed the state capitol and saw legislators in session. The Downtown Detroit Tour will take place in April.

WHEN THE Metropolitan board was formed 12 years ago, its purpose was fund-raising for international scholarships. Since that time its duties have been expanded to include sponsoring trips that would broaden the AFS students' knowledge of Michigan and the Detroit area.
