HERE COMES THE

Have you given half the thought to culinary art that you have to the art of personal adornment? I'll bet my brand new bonnet you haven't. But now that he is "captured," your problem has only just begun. Don't let any "mean" tell you all you have to do is to keep young and beautiful, if you want to be loved. This may be correct, if you provide "him" with good home-cooked food.

Whatever you do, keep that longing out of his mind for the dishes that "mother used to make." After all, SHE learned to cook—and so can you.

For instance . . .
That Cherry Pie
Can you bake a cherry pie? My little bride, little bride? Can you bake a cherry pie? For your dear Willie?
If you CAN'T bake cherry pie 'Cause he'll ask the reason why Then you'll be sure to cry, And feel quite silly.

Cherry Pie
2 cups fresh or canned sour cherries, drained.
1-2 or 3-4 cup sugar (as desired sweet or tart)
2 tablespoons flour
1-4 teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon butter

Combine sugar, flour and salt and mix with the cherries. Fill pan lined with pastry and dot with the butter. Cover with top crust. Press edges together securely prick or slash the top. Place in a hot oven of 450 degrees F. for 10 minutes. Reduce heat to 350 degrees F. and bake 40 or 45 minutes. If you cannot get the fresh cherries remember canned, red, pitted sour cherries are excellent.

Be Practical
It is all very well to try your hand at dainty salads and desserts but do not forget that "he" will want some good solid food. Select a nice sensible slice of ham and watch his pleased expression when he comes to the table. Dress it up a bit like this . . .

Ham Baked In Milk
1 two-inch slice ham
2 tablespoons brown sugar
1 tablespoon flour
3-4 cup water

Trim the fat from ham, cut into small pieces and mix with the sugar. Rub ham with flour when put into a baking dish. Sprinkle the fat-sugar mixture over the top and pour water around ham. Bake in a hot oven of 425 degrees F. for 15 minutes, then reduce the temperature to a slow oven of 275 degrees F. Add the milk 15 minutes before the ham is done. Two hours are usually required for baking. Enough milk should remain for gravy.

Yield: 6 servings.
A Refreshing Toast
But not a spirited one! Just the same, those few you choose to entertain, will smack their lips when they taste this delectable concoction based on tomato juice.

Tomato Juice Cocktail
3-4 cup Evaporated Milk
3-4 cup water or chilled ice
2-1-4 cups tomato juice
Celery salt
1-2 teaspoon salt

Dash of black pepper
All ingredients should be cold. Mix milk and water. Stir in the tomato juice. Add seasoning. This may be poured into the tray of an automatic refrigerator, frozen to

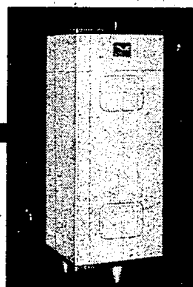
