# ROMEO STRIPPED OF ITS APPLE CROP, CONTINUES PLANS

Romeo, Aug. 23.—They're going to sell apple wood at the Michigan Peach Festival this year. Last spring the cold weather ruined the peach crop at Romeo but the orchard men still expected to have a good apple crop. Then the drought came along and the apple crop prospects dwindled to about 50 per cent. Still they had hopes and went ahead with plans for the Fourth Annual Michigan Peach Festival to be held in Romeo on Sept. 1, 2 and 3.

Then on Aug. 2 the worst wind storm in history here blew down fruit trees in the orchards and stripped those left standing. That was not discouraged and plans for the Festival are nearly completed. Remembering the old adage that "It's an ill wind that blows no good," it has been decided by the Festival committee to turn the damage done by the big wind storm to good advantage—they are going to use the blown-down trees as their medium of currency during the Festival. The wood from the trees is being made into wooden nickels which will be distributed by merchants in Romeo and nearby communities. The issue will be printed as a memorial of the Fourth Annual Michigan Peach Festival, its feature attraction, "The Pageant of Fruit," and the wind storm. The wooden currency will be given out in change by merchants and will be accepted for full cash value. Collectors are already demanding the currency. It will be issued soon.

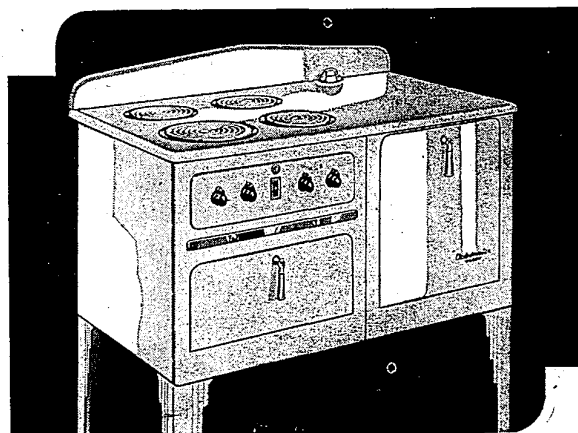
