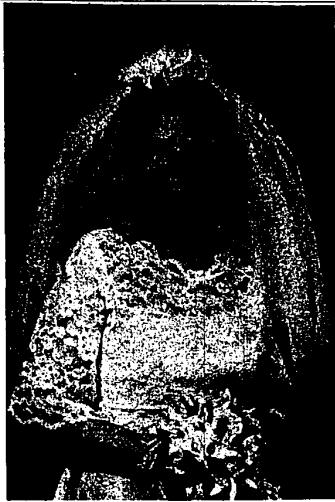
**TERESA BUTLER**
