

Ask New Vote On Job Bill


Nineteenth District Democratic chairman Aldo Vagnozzi has called on Congressman Jack McDonald (R-Livonia, Farmington) to vote to override President Nixon's veto of the public works bill which will create thousands of jobs across the nation.

"With the nation's unemployment figure still hovering around the 8.5 percent mark, I believe this bill is needed to create thousands of jobs which will put some of those jobless to work while giving the economy a much needed shot in the arm," Vagnozzi wrote the Congressman.

At the same time the 19th District Democratic executive board took the following action in relation to state legislative issues:

- Called on chairman David Holmes of the House Social Services Committee to report out the abortion reform bill so that the entire membership of the House will have an opportunity to vote on the bill.
- Urged area House members to support Marvin Stempien's (D-Livonia) bill on districting community college trustee elections with the option for an at-large election.
- Called on the Senate to pass the age of majority bill in the same form that it was adopted in the House.

The 19th Democrats are planning an issues conference and major fund-raising activity in the fall.

LANSING children when such services are not available, Pursell explained.

Also included in the amendment as tantamount to job refusal, the senator said, are:

- 1) Failure to obtain and file a new certificate with the county department of social services at least once every two weeks from the Employment Security Commission stating it has no order for an opening in part-time, full-time, temporary or permanent employment in which the applicant is able to engage, or
- 2) Willfully fails to report for an employment interview when requested to do so by the commission, or
- 3) Willfully fails to report to the commission on the result of an employment referral, or
- 4) Willfully fails to report for employment.

Pursell warned: "If legislative measures are not undertaken soon to stem the ever-increasing tide of expenditures for welfare assistance, this state will face a financial dilemma of such magnitude that the heretofore used avenue of appropriations cannot in good conscience be voted for in support of its continuance."

"Employable" as defined in the amendment is a person under 65 years of age, whose health would not prevent working and who is not engaged full-time in attending school (in case of a minor), participating in an approved, vocational or rehabilitation program, wholly caring for incapacitated household members or caring for
