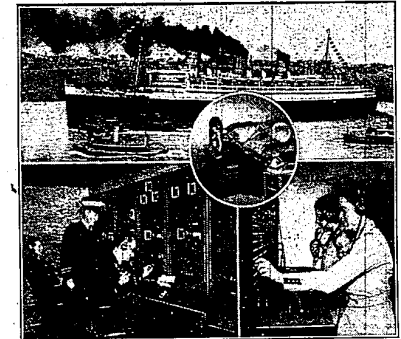


New Liner Queen Mary Has Double Ship-to-Shore Telephone Circuits
