Officer in charge Roger A. Boggs of the Southfield Posts Office, reminded postal customers today that a new program is available which can provide blanket protection against unsolicited mailings of sexually oriented advertisements.

Boggs said participating citizens need only give their names and addresses to the Postal Service to guard against being sent sexually oriented ads, even if they have never received such materials.

THE LAW allows an in-dividual to ask the Postal Service, for himself and on behalf of his minor children under 19, that he not receive such material from any source.

"Once a person's name, has been on the list more than 30 days, the prohibilion becomes effective, and a mailer must not send sexually oriented ads to him," Boggs said.
"If a mailer sends sex ads to a person named on the Postal Service list for 30 days or more, the mailer is subject to civil action or criminal

civil action or criminal prosecution," he said.

APPROXIMATELY 215,000 persons already have taken advantage of the anti-smut program since it went into effect February 1 as part of the Postal Reorganization

Act.
The new program, complements the 1988 Pandering Advertisements Law, which allows citizens a means to shut off mailings from a particular smut peddler.
