

The most versatile airplane in history is now helping to fight corn blight in Michigan.

Michigan State University and University of Michigan scientists are using a C-47 "gooney bird" with advanced photographic and infrared scanning equipment to spot corn crop diseases from the air.

Designed as a-luxury airliner in the mid-1830s, C-47s flew cargo over "the Hump" from India to China during WW II, helped break he Bering III Blockade, ferried troops in Korea, and now patrol the skies over Vietnam as a heavily armed gunships.
