

Most of the Holcombes of the New England states trace their ancienty to Thomas, and so some families in other states.

Then there was John Holcombe, a Quaker, who emigrated from England in 1700, and settled in Philadelphia, and also his brother Jacob, who located in Lambertville, N. J.
