

# Meadow Brook Presents 'Fidelio'



The 1971 Meadow Brook Music Festival moves into its seventh week with two full-length concert performances of Beethoven's opera, "Fidelio".

Perhaps the most rarely performed of the world's truly great operas, it contains some of Beethoven's most inspired music.

From the overture to the

mighty fugue for orchestra, chorus, and soloists that ends the work, "Fidelio" is one of Beethoven's grandest achievements.

"WE HOPE," said Meadow Brook Music Festival manager Sander Kallai, "that these performances of 'Fidelio' will mark the beginning of annual productions of opera at

Meadow Brook. It's an ambitious undertaking and one that we feel sure will produce exciting results." Soloists for the "Fidelio" performances on Thursday, Aug. 5, and Saturday, Aug. 7, will be tenor William Cochran as Florestan, soprano, Doris Jung as Leonore, baritone Morley Meredith as Pizarro and Detroit-born bass Ara Berberian as Rocco.
