President Roosevelt sent congratulations to the Boy Scouts in a radio talk on the anniversary of their founding. The President urged community support of scouting as a youth movement "which seeks to preserve such simple fundamentals as physical strength, mental alertness and moral straightness."

There are Boy Scouts established in Germany, France, Italy, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, and the South American Republics. The largest membership is in the United States.

The purpose of the Boy Scouts is summed up in the twelve points of the Scout Law, which requires boys to be: Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, Reverent, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient and Cheerful.

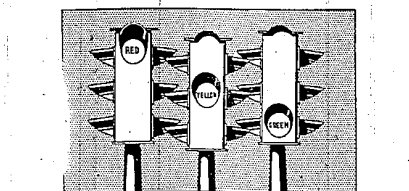
