

Overseas Phone Calls Are All in the Day's Work to Girls Who Handle Them

Radiotelephone service between New York and London was put into operation eleven years ago. Today, radiotelephone service is available between this country and more than 70 foreign countries...

"On your call to London, we are ready."

It was eleven years ago that an American telephone operator first felt the thrill of those words...

Even today, with telephone service extending from this country to all of the world's continents...

Most Calls Are for Americans. To the overseas operators, however, working at the switchboards in New York and San Francisco and Miami, Fla. where the overseas radiotelephone circuits terminate...

Of the 24 distant countries or territories in which Bell System overseas circuits terminate, the native language is English in the case of five, French in two, Spanish in thirteen, Portuguese in one, Dutch one, Chinese one, and Chinese one...

About 75 per cent of the calls are scattered as soon as it is possible to complete them, but the remaining 25 per cent are filed for completion at a later time, or even a later day...

Overseas operators not only must know how to handle the switchboard, but they must know their geography. For example, Vienna is Vienna in this country, but in Europe it is Wien, while Leghorn becomes Livorno, and Munich is München.

Since overseas calls are dealt with in French, the question of language comes to the fore. In Europe, the general rule is that any international service may be operated in the language agreed upon between the telephone administrations...

Of the 24 distant countries or territories in which Bell System overseas circuits terminate, the native language is English in the case of five, French in two, Spanish in thirteen, Portuguese in one, Dutch one, Chinese one, and Chinese one...

The overseas services have shown marked and continued improvement since their inauguration eleven years ago. Then the average time required to complete a New York-London call was about 45 minutes...

A Bit of Advice on Being Dressed Fit to Kill

If novice hunters who are planning to make their first deer hunting trip this season, will take the advice of veteran hunters, they will avoid wearing heavy clothing, according to the Michigan Department of Conservation.

One of the most common errors on the part of green hunters, noted by conservation officers on their patrol of hunting camps during the deer season, is that of supposing that in order to keep warm one must be weighted down like a freighter...

Another frequent mistake of green hunters, is to wear clothing which binds, which further reduces what little energy they have left after carting around an excessive poundage in clothes...

State Posters Give Six Hunting Rules

As part of department of conservation efforts to reduce the number of hunting accidents, attention is called again to a few fundamental rules in the use of a gun in the woods.

Posters have been distributed throughout the state showing right and wrong ways to handle a gun. These are:

When removing a gun from an automobile pull it out butt first, not muzzle first.

When walking in the woods, do not carry your gun so that the muzzle is pointing at any other hunter.

When sitting down to rest, do not leave guns on ground where your dogs may accidentally discharge one—place guns out of reach on stump.

When two are in canoe, only one should attempt to use gun and he should be in bow.

In climbing a fence, put gun through first—do not attempt to climb with it in your hand.

And a good general promise to go on is that every gun is always loaded.
