Church membership is a matter of religion; that is, it is a matter of religion if it is worth anything. And it is a serious business. Church membership must be religious! More than that it must he Christian! And to be Christian it must, first of all, be honest. Therefore, the person must have a reason for belonging to the church. And it must be a reason that goes deeper than tradition or sentiment or persuation by friends or by the minister. Church membership is such serious business that it is our belief that any one who does not have a real, religious reason for his church membership is not honest, either with himself or with the church.
