## ALL HOMES SHOULD HAVE EQUIPMENT TO FIGHT FIRES

A recent bulletin of the National Board of Fire Underwriters deals with the immensely important subject of "Fire Equipment in the Home" and that is something that comes straight home to everyone.

Adequate home fire-fighting equipment is simple and cheap—in fact, you probably have most of what you need on hand now. Many a potentially destructive fire has been quickly extinguished with a garden hose. Short pieces of hose kept inside the house near faucets may come in handy. And that simplest of all protective devices, a pail of water, may be a lifesaver in an emergency.

**Water May Spread Fire**  
Water is obviously the agent to use for most fires—but it shouldn't be forgotten that in some cases water will spread, not quench a fire. In the instance of kitchen fires involving grease, for instance, the application of water is likely to

result in a sudden burst of flame that will send the fire to all corners of the room. A fire of this kind should be fought by covering the burning receptacle in order to shut off the air supply, after turning off all heat.

Closest fires can often be smothered by simply closing the door. In any event, no matter where the fire is, close all doors that will tend to confine it.

Every householder will do well to buy one or two extinguishers of an effective and inexpensive type, of which there are many approved makes on the market. Foam and gas extinguishers are the most efficient agents for quenching oil fires.

**Suggestions**  
Lastly, the National Board's bulletin offers a number of suggestions for home fire fighting which should be kept always in mind:  
1. Never attempt to fight fire in a smoke-filled room or basement—poisonous fumes may overcome you.  
2. Never enter a room where much fire is in evidence.  
3. Women should not attempt to fight fire, wearing cotton or silk dresses—a human life is worth more than property.  
4. See that everyone is out of danger before you fight the fire.  
5. Money spent for fire prevention, such as approved electrical appliances, repairs to chimneys and heating plants, fire stops, etc., is more worth while than that spent for extinguishing equipment.

**Highway Department To Seek No More Funds**

State Highway Commissioner Murray D. Van Wagoner assured Governor Dickinson this week that his department would take no part in any "pressure" movement for increased funds from the legislature.

"I have noted your prayerful appeal that the legislature be free from pressure in its efforts to balance the budget and think it is deserving of the support of every department of the state government," a letter from the commissioner said. "I want you to know that the state highway department has not sought additional funds in this session of the legislature nor will it do so."

The letter called attention to a legislative effort in a bill to suspend the department's general and appropriation for two years. The commissioner said that, while the measure would require further departmental economies, he was agreeable to its enactment in view of its "contribution to a balanced budget."

**Indemnity Payments On Cattle Stopped**

Payment of indemnities for cattle reacting to Bang's Disease tests were discontinued in Michigan May 1, according to Elmer A. Beamer, commissioner of Department of Agriculture. The United States Bureau of Animal Industry, which has conducted campaign against the disease during the past five years, discontinued payments under the provision which prohibits the federal agency from payment of amount in excess of that paid by the cooperating state.

With legislation providing for an appropriation for the continuance of the program, federal authorities are continuing the testing of cattle, but are not branding reactors to the disease. In event appropriation measure becomes a law, making funds available, the reactors will be branded and slaughtered with payments being made as in the past.

Anticipated production of fish during 1939 at the Wolf lake state fish hatchery, largest diversified fish hatchery in the world, is between 15,000,000 and 20,000,000 fish. Principal species propagated and reared at the hatchery are large and small mouth bass, bluegills, brook, brown and rainbow trout and Montana grayling.
