Marilyn Howell of Livonia will play the Queen. Miss Howell has appeared in Bentley High School musicals and with the LRTG.

Deborah Messer of Farmington, who is now a drama major at Wayne State University, is taking the role of the Princess. Miss Messer has appeared with the Farmington Village Players, the Farmington Players and the Henry K. Martin Children's Company.

A newcomer to the local stage, Emily Sharp of Livonia, is playing the Witch in "Magic Tinderbox." She is a student at Dickinson Junior High School.

Robert H. Rogez is founder and director of the new company.

Rogez lives in Livonia and teaches in Pierce Junior High School in Redford Township. He is also writer for the group, making musicals of familiar fairy tales. The company now has in rehearsal a Scandinavian folk tale, "East of the Sun and West of Moon," scheduled for early fall production.

Rogez is also working on a winter production of "The Nightingale" by Andersen, and an Easter opening for "Mollie Whuppie" an English fairy tale.
