

# Transfer Approved By Township Board

**FARMINGTON**  
The Farmington Township board has agreed to the transfer of \$200,000 to general funds to meet operating costs until collection of tax revenues.

The \$200,000 is being "borrowed" without interest from the township improvement revolving fund to be paid back by March 31, 1972.

**CLERK FLOYD, CAIRNS** likened the transfer to the practice of school boards borrowing money from banks to be paid back when state aid payments are made or taxes are collected. These are called tax anticipation notes.

Trustee Fred Lichtman said the township will be collecting \$200,000 in local tax revenue but, to date, has received only 12 per cent of this amount or about \$24,000.

"It is impossible to operate on IOU's," Lichtman said, adding that of the \$200,000 due in state revenues, only about 25 per cent has been paid during the first four months of the present township budget year which began April 1.
