

Unexploded, shells are still being found in the war zone of France it years after the World war. A private company which was engaged six years ago to hunt and destroy them is still actively certaing duriters in Control of the "Big Berden" which thelled Paris. Besides doing its own bunking, the company is informed of the accidental finding of shells. It sends its special trucks, fitted for handling explosives, and the shell is taken to the exploding ground.
