

Free Entertainment Array Is Sensational

From the time Bimbo's Gaslighters from Ann Arbor take over the Kellogg Park bandstand at 5 p.m. Thursday until the nationally acclaimed Plymouth High School band concludes its concert late Sunday afternoon, the Fall Festival free entertainment schedule will offer onlookers one sensational act after another.

Entertainment Chairman Daisy Proctor has arranged an array of variety features that will satisfy all tastes during the four days of Plymouth's 16th annual fete.

Seating will be available for hundreds of persons in front of the bandstand and there will be no charge for any of the performances. The full entertainment timetable appears on page five.

The same bandshell area also will be the scene of two of the festival's most popular and traditional festivities Saturday,

although they aren't defined specifically as entertainment. Included will be the pet show at 9 a.m., guaranteed once again to draw just about all the kids in Plymouth, and the Gay '90s costume judging contest at 5 p.m.

Possibly the most eagerly awaited attraction of the entire entertainment schedule is the appearance of the American Legion Zouaves from Jackson at 3 p.m. Sunday, just about the time the Rotary Club's chicken barbecue is at its height.

Under the command of Bob Christian, the Zouaves will present the same spectacular exhibit of precision drilling they have given six times on the Ed Sullivan TV show and in all the major cities of America and Europe. Their formations are interspersed with rifle manuals, at an amazing cadence of 300 steps per minute.
