

# Art Show A 'First'

The Plymouth Arts Council has undertaken one of the boldest projects of the 1971 Fall Festival by planning an arts and crafts show to be held Saturday and Sunday in Central Junior High School across from City Hall.

"That show will consist of demonstrations of arts and crafts on a raised platform, a sales booth of student arts and crafts, and a 'clothesline' display of student artwork," explained Mrs. Wilma Newton, chairman of the project.

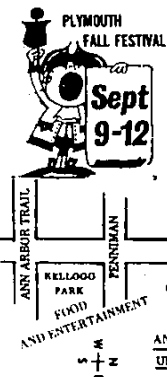
"Forty-four professional artisans from throughout Michigan will participate.

"In addition to the oil and water painting, rug weaving, pottery making and such, there will be performances of the puppet

show, 'Rumpelstiltskin,' on Saturday and plays presented by the Plymouth Youth Theatre on Sunday."

Mrs. Richard Foy and Mrs. John Armstrong, serving as co-chairmen, have suggested that festival goers begin their tour of activities at the junior high school, where the large parking area behind the school will be available. It is a two-block walk from there to Kellogg Park.

This is the first year the Arts Council has attempted such a show and proceeds will go toward financing its year-around program of bringing cultural attractions into Plymouth schools. It also hopes to schedule an appearance of the new Michigan Artrain in Plymouth in 1972.
