

Patrons Get Opportunity To Aid Fete

Lee Anderson, nine-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Anderson, of 5840 Tower Rd., Plymouth, became perhaps the youngest land speculator of his community recently by purchasing one-quarter of a square foot of a vacant downtown lot from Fall Festival President Joe West.

He turned over \$1 of his own allowance for an impressive, though non-legal, deed of trust, acknowledging his contribution to a unique fund raising campaign being conducted by directors of the festival.

If up to 55,000 other community residents will follow the boy's example, the board can purchase the 13,901 square foot lot between the Penn Theatre and Masonic Temple on Penniman Ave.

Because it is located directly across from Kellogg Park, the lot is used throughout the festival by service organizations as the site for serving more than 20,000 specialty dinners during the four-day event. The tables for dining are set up in the park.

Charles P. Finlan, who owns the lot, has donated its use to the festival for many years, but directors are convinced of the wisdom of buying it as a permanent possession and then mapping year-around activities for the land. The price is \$46,622, with five per cent down and a 10-year mortgage at seven per cent.

THE BOARD is trying to raise the money through the Deed of Trust campaign, giving each \$1 contributor a figurative claim to a fourth of a square foot. The immediate goal is to raise \$2,331.10 to meet the Oct. 1 down payment deadline in order to exercise an option to buy.

"Buy a plot and share a lot of the Fall Festival" is the campaign theme and directors will sell the trust deeds from a booth in Kellogg Park through the 1971 Festival.

"Because of its ideal location and the increasing numbers of people who attend the festival, I'm not sure how we would handle the concessions without it," said West.

He said he also believes that by making it available to other local organizations for worthwhile activities, the project will yield returns as a community investment.
