BIRMINGHAM Fifty-five classes comprise the curriculum for the fall term of studio art courses being offered this fall by the Bloomfield Art Association, 1516 S. Cranbrook Rd. Registration for the 10-week fall term begins Sept. 7 and continues through Sept. 25. The term begins Sept. 27.

BESIDES PAINTING, drawing and sketching, metal sculpture, macramé, jewelry, glass craftsmanship, loom weaving, rug hooking and photography will be offered for adult students. Courses of study are available for students at all levels of ability, beginner through professional. Special classes for children and young people are open to students six years of age through senior high school.

A "discovery class" is designed to introduce the very beginner to all media.

INCLUDED ON THE faculty of the BAA are professional artist-craftsmen, such as Bruce Blyth in jewelry; Renee Radell in painting; Urban Jupena in weaving; and Barbara Whittenberg in macramé.
