

State Budget's 'Built-ins' Price Tag \$220 Million

LANSING -- Michigan faces built-in budget increases amount-ing to \$220 million in fiscal 1969-70, according to Charles O, Zollar, chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee, Next year's \$1,5 billion record-shattering budget compares with estimated spending of \$1,3 billion for the fiscal year ending next June 30.

Increasing costs of existing programs, higher salaries, and

EAST LANSING -- Fund raising has been more difficult the past two years at Michigan State University because of an abnormal amount" of student probast activities, according John R. Kinney, executive director of the MSU Alumni Associ-

"There exists among alumni and friends of the university a suspicion that makes fund raising that much more difficult." Kinney said, "but despite this we have done well, which sto the conclusion that the majority of people who complain would not have contributed anyhow."

LANSING -- Zolton A, Ferency, former Democratic state chairman, said that he will refuse to act as a Democratic presidential elector when Michigan casts the state's 21 electoral college votes.

Ferency, who had been a McCarthy supporter, explained that his decision represented a further protest against the policies of President Johnson's administration. Humphrey's win in the state automatically gave the privilege of casting Michigan's electoral votes to the state of electora chosen at the Democratic State Convention Aug. 31 in Grand Rapids.

WASHINGTON -- Atty. Gen. Rameey Clark strongly dealed reports that he had directed the rewriting of a critical report on Chicago police violence at the Democratic National Convention.

WHITE CASTLE, LA. -- No sign has been found of the 17 missing crewmen who were aboard a Coast Guard ship silced in half by a Formosan freighter in the murky waters of the lower Miceleschet.
