BEAMER ADVISES CHECK OF POTATO BRANDING


Declaring that potato sales methods of some rotall outlets are proving detrimental to the Industry, and especially undair to Michigan producers. Agricultural Comissioner: Elmer A. Beander advised inspectors of the importance of thorough check of the brajuliar, as to grade of all potatoes being offered at retail. The department head pointed out that state tradiantses and trademarks alid not names and trademarks did not constitute indication of grade, and that all potatoes must be clearly marked as to grade regardless of their origin:
