In April 115 of the gray partridges, imported from Alberta, Canada, where they were trapped from wild stock, were planted near St. Johns.
From 1928 to 1940, more than 2.209 hunkles have been released in likely southern Michigan locations in a program designed to establish this game bird where hunting pressure is high and increasing.
