The old adage that "actions speak louder than words," once more was proven by the use of Russian dialogue in "Comrade X," now coming starring Clark Gable and Hedy Lamarr, and opening Friday at the Redford Theater for an engagement of four days.

Gable plays a dandy American newspaperman, and Miss Lamarr a Moscow lady street car "motorman" in the hilarious story, which required some Russian speeches for flavor.

But although there were thirty-one lines of Russian dialogue in the script, ranging from many one word utterances to a 350-word speech, writers Ben Hecht and Charles Lederer found occasion to have only fifteen lines of them translated for Gable, so that the audience would know what was being said.

Others Thrown in  
All the others were merely thrown in as Russian, with the actors indicating through gestures, mood and pantomime the meaning of what they were saying.

The translation of the English "Russian" lines, in the scene was done by Andrew Tolstoy, technical adviser and great-grand-nephew of the famous Russian novelist, Leo Tolstoy. He put the eighty-one "lines" into Russian, performing a task which was far from simple, substituting Russian for English words. He was required to use synonyms and altered phrases which the non-Russian actors could speak correctly since Russian contains many words strange to other nationalities.

"Comrade X" marks the first appearance together of Gable and Miss Lamarr since their joint triumph in "Boom Town." Prominent in support of the stars are Oscar

HOT PORRIDGE FOR BREAKFAST WILL SUPPLY ENERGY

Serving piping hot porridge for breakfast supplies energy-giving food at low cost and temperature drop and appetites soar. Two common porridge faults are lumpiness and lack of salt, according to the home economics staff at Michigan State College. The lumpiness can be avoided by the right method of combining the cereal. A quick way is to add the cereal slowly to rapidly boiling water, and stir until all the cereal is blended in. Another way is to add the cold water to the cereal and let it stand the two thoroughly before heating.

The standard amount of salt to add is about one teaspoon for every quart of water used in cooking cereal. This may vary according to taste, but it should never be left out, because it brings out the starchy flavor.

If porridge is made ahead of time then allowed to cool, two or three teaspoons of water can be poured over the top to prevent a hard crust from forming. When reheating porridge, do not stir until the cereal is heated through. Otherwise lumps of the cooked cereal may form.

The homemaker operating on a limited food budget can serve only two or three cereal dishes a day, in addition to bread at every meal. If money is so limited that there's enough to buy only the minimum of fruit and vegetables, at least half of the cereal served should be whole grain rather than refined so that this food furnishes some of the vitamins and minerals.
