## Sailboat Show Is First For Midwest

The first annual Great Lakes Sailboat Show, an in-water, all-sailboat show will be held Friday, Oct. 8, to Monday, Oct. 11, at Metropolitan Beach, near Mt. Clemens.

The show should be of in-

terest to many sailors because sailboats, particularly large ones, are not generally carried as stock items by local boat dealers. Usually the only way an interested sailor can see the majority of sailboats on the market is in pictures or by traveling around the country to see where the boats are built.

The show will, for the first time in the Midwest, put a great number of new sailboats together in the water to be looked at and sized up by sailors and prospective sailors.

Show hours are from 4 to 10 p.m. on Friday and from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

There will also be an educational program, featuring almost continuous demonstrations of small boats sailing in a lagoon while an expert explains the various maneuvers to an audience in the bleachers. There will also be a schedule of small boat races in the North Lagoon. There will be racing seminars conducted by experts, as well as talks and films by sailmakers, boat designers and so on.

The show is being produced by Jack Leverenz.
