

Health Commissioner Urges Dog Quarantine

If you have a mad dog scare these hot summer days, don't shoot the dog that bites you but tie him up. Then you quite likely won't have to take Pasteur treatments, says the Michigan Department of Health.

"Tying up a suspected dog is a sure way of finding whether or not Pasteur treatments are called for since the dog, if mad, dies within ten days," says Dr. H. Allen Moore, State Health Commissioner.

"When dogs are shot or when they cannot be found after biting someone, the physician will feel that Pasteur treatments are necessary, since you can be sure that the dog was not rabid. That's why so much more rabies vaccine is used in Michigan than would be needed to treat persons actually bitten by mad dogs.

"Recent months, dog heads found positive for rabies on laboratory examinations have averaged one a day—but the number of persons starting Pasteur treatments has been at least ten a day and sometimes 25 or more a day.

"Hot weather will mean more dog bites, although not necessarily more rabid dogs. For that reason, it is particularly important to avoid unnecessary Pasteur treatments. For peace of mind and for better protection, tie up the biting dog and don't rush into treatments unless the bites are about the face.

Dog heads found positive for rabies are more numerous now than at the end of the 47-county quarantine which ran from April to September last year, but the total of 39 in April and 28 in May is less than a third of the number found each month before the quarantine was established jointly by the Departments of Health and of Agriculture. In addition, an unknown number of dogs die of rabies without confirmation of the infection by laboratory examination.

So far in 1941, the Department of Agriculture has established quarantines in seven areas at the request of local authorities, each for 30 days. The areas follow: townships in Washtenaw county; five townships in Berrien, three in Clinton, three in Eaton, four in Ingham, and the whole counties of Saginaw and St. Clair.

(Continued from Page Two) under the tentative plan. Domestic washing and ironing machines will be cut 30 per cent initially, more stringently later. Refrigerator production will be limited to 150,000 units a month.

Upward adjustments in ceiling prices on cotton grey goods and couched cotton yarn were allowed by OPACS to cover increased operating costs following meetings with the Cotton Textile Advisory Panel. As a result, cotton print cloth, held at 32 cents a pound will return to the May level of 43 cents.

OPACS gave the highest civilian priority rating to raw materials used in the manufacture of hospital equipment, surgical implements and supplies, and eyeglass frames and parts in two civilian allocation orders.

Authorized defense expenditures approached \$50,000,000 June 30, last, the OPM Bureau of Research and Statistics disclosed. Appropriations, contract authorizations, RFC funds aggregated nearly \$46,000,000. British contracts added \$3,671,000,000.

More Guns Produced As evidence that this money is being converted at an increasing rate into planes, ships, tanks, and guns, the OPM Production Division called attention to rifle and sub-machine gun production. The present rate is 1,500 a day as against 239 last January.
