Twelve nationally-known museum directors and art critics will participate in a three-day symposium at the Detroit Institute of Arts Thursday through Saturday, Oct. 21, 22 and 23, as one of many public events planned in honor of the museum's North Wing dedication.

Each session begins at 11 a.m. and will be open to the public in the museum lecture hall.

"THE MUSEUM in Contemporary Society" will be the theme for the following panel discussions:

Thursday, "What Is an Art Museum?" with Peter Selz, director, University of California Art Museum at Berkeley; Sherman E. Lee, director, Cleveland (Ohio) Museum of Art; Bryan Robertson, director, the Museum of Visual Arts, State University of New York; and

Walter Hopps, director, the Corcoran Gallery of Art, Washington, D.C.

Friday, "Involvement: Collector, Volunteer, Critic," with Henry Hopkins, director, Fort Worth Art Center Museum; Clement Greenberg, art critic and author; Theodore Rousseau, vice-director and curator-in-chief, Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York City.

Saturday, "The Museum as an Educational Force," with Harry S. Parker III, vice director of education, Metropolitan Museum of Arts; Joshua Taylor, director, National Collection of Fine Arts, Washington, D.C.; Martin Friedman, director, Walker Art Center, Minneapolis, Minn.; and Dominique De Menil, art patron and trustee, Institute of Arts, Rice University, Houston, Texas.

# Jimmy Webb Concert Set

Composer-performer Jimmy Webb will be presented in concert at Schoolcraft College, 18600 Haggerty, Livonia, Sunday, Oct. 17.

The Jimmy Webb concert, sponsored by the student activities board, will get under way at 8 p.m. in the gymnasium. Advance tickets may be purchased by mail, and the checks should be made payable to Schoolcraft College, 18600 Haggerty, Livonia, 48151, c/o Student Activities Board. Tickets are also on sale at the Wayne State University ticket office. They are \$3 for the general public and \$1.50 for Schoolcraft students.

Webb's career began at the age of 18, when he wrote a golden record, "Up, Up and Away." This started a string of Webb hits for the Fifth Dimension. Then came Glenn Campbell for whom he wrote "By the Time I Get to Phoenix," "Galveston" and "Wichita Lineman," followed by "The Worst That Could Happen," a hit for the Brooklyn Bridge.

By the time he was 24, Webb had written around 10 compositions, along with several albums, giving him a total of 11 Grammy Awards. Webb also picked up a Grammy in 1969 for best arrangement for the record "MacArthur Park."
