ON HIS PERSONAL report Each listed no expenditures on receipts. His campaign effort came through 14 committees, each of which spent close to the \$5,000 legal maximum.

VIVIAN'S PERSONAL ex-penses report showed expenses and contributions of \$1,609, all from the "Wes Vivian for Con-gress" Committee.

Vivian's support came from four committees, with "Wes

"Scientists and Engineers for Vivian" listed balanced expens-es and receipts of \$33. The South Monroe Committee for Vivian listed expenses of \$500 and a single contribution for the same amount -- from Mrs, Elizabeth Barlow of Ann Arbor,

"Citizens for Vivian" spent \$7,208 and took in \$7,210, with \$5,000 coming from "Solidar-ity House," the name of the headquarters of the United Auto Workers union.

Party conffibutions to Vivian were less than a third of Viv-ian's resources whereas they constituted two a thirds of Esch's. The party gave Vivian \$8,970.

ORGANIZED LABOR did bet-ter, contributing nearly \$15,000 to the Vivian effort, Major con-tributors included:
