In keeping the garden free of blight, a list of the disease peculiar to certain of the common vegetables, with the preventative or cure, may be useful to the amatteur gardener.



Yellow Witt is a common destroyer of the cabbage, and the oaily known preventative is the use of resistant varieties in the garden; such as Marion Market or Globelback Rot, another common ehemy, can be prevented by soakling the cabbage seed in water healed to 120 degrees for thirty minutes. Swell of the plant, which dry linto a mass of smut pores. Cut off the bolls and burn.
