Plans are well under way for the eleventh annual Oakland County Tag Day sponsored by the St. Joseph's Mercy Hospital Auxiliary, Saturday, June 27 has been designated as Tag Day and the drive will be conducted simultaneously in every city and village in the county.

Contributions obtained on Tag Day are used in support of the clinic of St. Joseph's Mercy Hospital where medical care is available to any needy person without discrimination as to race, creed or residence. During 1941-42 over 10,112 cases were treated from all parts of Oakland county. More than 575 pairs of glasses were fitted.

Several very valuable pieces of medical equipment have been purchased and installed with funds collected on Tag Day, the largest of which have been two new X-ray incubators for premature babies. With the construction of the St. Joseph's Mercy Hospital Auxiliary will be enabled to assist with additional equipment through the generosity of Tag Day contributors. 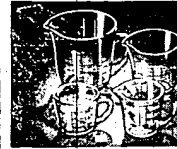
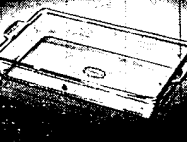
