Brown Gilbert of the Highland Park Baptist Church, the general theme of his talk will be on Consecration. There will be special music by Fred Gilbert.

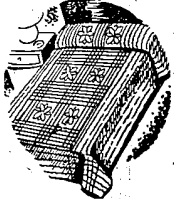
Plans are under way for the Annual Rally and Promotion Sunday on September 27. This is a combined service of the church and Sunday School at 10:30 a.m.
