A GRADUATE of CentralMichigan University, Irish taught in Evart, Clawson and at CMU before coming to Clarenceville schools. After leaving here in 1966, he went to Berkley schools as purchasing agent and from there to a construction company as its purchasing agent in 1968.

After he left the construction company and moved with his wife to Williamston, Irish, 62, took the bank manager job to keep busy.

the bank, shot Irish twice and
fled with \$20,000.
