## Cigarette Papers Of Marijuana?

Q. Is it true that you can  
buy cigarette papers made out  
of marijuana? I mean legally?

S.R., Redford

A. Yes, you certainly can.  
There is only one small hooker  
to this, however: there's no  
effect at all produced by these  
papers. What they are made  
from is the stems of mari-  
juana plants. These stems  
contain no active such as  
THC to produce a "high." And  
for this reason there is no  
legal restrictions regarding  
this part of the plant.

It is interesting to note that  
the promoters of these  
cigarette papers don't men-  
tion these facts. Rather  
one is given the impression  
that a "high" will be  
produced.

The best cigarette papers  
for any purpose are rice  
papers. The marijuana  
papers, which are of inferior  
quality, sell for four times as  
much.

Q. What do you think about  
John Sinclair finally being  
freed from a 10-year prison  
sentence for possession of two  
marijuana cigarettes? Should  
he have been let off? And was  
the concert with John and  
Yoko Lennon protesting his  
imprisonment what forced the  
state to free him?

A. Well, most people in the  
field of drug abuse felt that the  
former laws which treated  
marijuana as a narcotic (with  
penalties to match) were too  
harsh. We are inclined to  
agree with them. It would  
follow then that Sinclair had  
been imprisoned too long. This  
should not imply a blanket  
endorsement of his life-style.

As for that protest concert,  
it could be classified as an act  
of statesmanship rather than  
of protest. (Statesmanship  
has been defined as "firmly  
out where the parade is going,  
and then getting in front of it.")

It was common knowledge  
that when the new marijuana  
law went into effect John  
Sinclair was as good as free.  
And this was before the  
concert. We much preferred  
the intent of the earlier rock  
concert by John Harrison, Bob  
Dylan and Ravi Shankar to  
help keep the millions of  
Bangladesh from starving.

## Hospital Courses At Marygrove

A new series of nine and 10  
week allied health courses will  
be offered at Marygrove  
College beginning Saturday,  
Feb. 12 through April 29. The  
college is located at Mc-  
Nichols (Six Mile) and  
Wyoming in Detroit.

Hospital personnel who wish  
to upgrade their positions,  
veterans with medical corps  
experience and other adults  
who wish to go into hospital

for these courses.

Brewington, director of the  
program. "Almost any kind of  
career imaginable outside of a  
hospital is to be found in the  
health field."

New courses include  
training for emergency room  
technical aides, ward  
secretaries, management  
supervisors and hospital  
business office specialists, x-  
ray technical aides, pharmacy  
aides and medication  
technicians, human relations  
and hospital finance  
technicians.

These are in addition to  
courses for beginning and  
advanced electro - car-  
diogram and operating room  
technicians, medical records  
technical aides and medical  
secretaries, medical ter-  
minology, computer  
techniques, laboratory  
technical, nurse and orderly  
aides.

The courses are offered  
evenings and Saturdays. Free  
parking and counseling are  
available.
