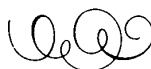

### GOP Leader Is Speaker

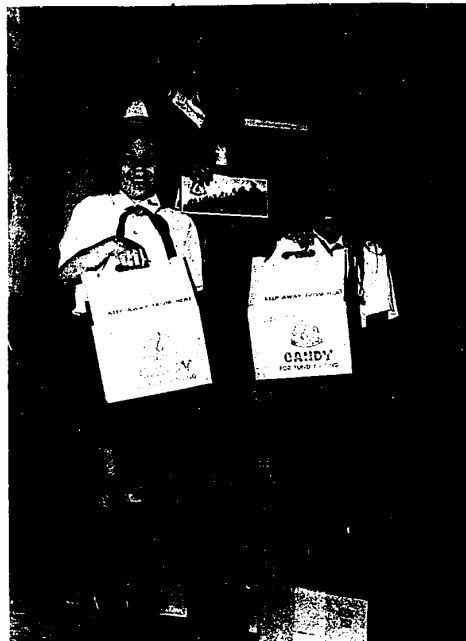

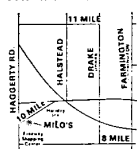
