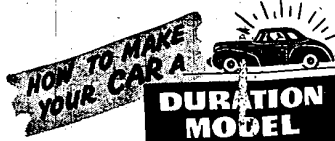

The young people of this group were guests of the Gospel Assembly Youth Group Thursday night.

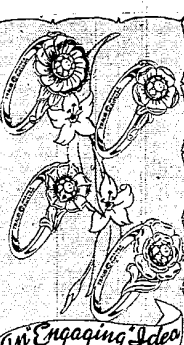
