Grates Require Attention
The importance of careful thing to prolong the life of grates is emphasized. The first and most important point in the care of grates is the frequent removal of the ashes in the ash pit. The ash pit is a storage chamber for air, not ashes. Air is necessary for the combustion of any fuel. Unless there is sufficient air below the grate bars, the fuel will burn or waste. Failure to remove the ashes as often as necessary causes a wasteful fire as well as warped or burned grates. Another important point in the care of grates is to prevent the formation of clinkers which are likely to lodge in the grates.
