Pederson of the Detroil In-migration and Naturalization office, the information fur-nished by aliens in reporting their address has been declared confidential by statute.

deciai e statute. statute. These reports must be submitted. during January each year by all aliens in the united States, with few ex-ceptions, Forms on which to submit the reports are available at any Post Office or office of the Immigration and Naturalization Service. Become who are unable to

Naturalization Service. Persons who are unable to pick up a form because of illness, or other reasons, may have a relative or friend ob-tain a card for them. The card should be returned to one of these offices. Parents or guardians of aliens under 14 years of age must submit reports for such children.
