Sen. William Faust (D-Westland) was absent for the vote and Sens. David Plaweck! (D-Dearborn Heights) and Daniel Cooper (D-Oak Park) voted against it. The split followed party lines.

THE BILL passed in a 20 to 11 vote (20 votes are needed for passage) and was referred to the House for concurrence on amendments. It had been passed by the House in a 73-19 vote just before it recessed for Christmas.

Opponents of the Senate

vote just before it recessed for Christmas.

Opponents of the Senate version said it watered the bill down, rendering it ineffective. The House had approved a version that would permit local ordinances to dighten state controls on the site and placement of billiboards. The State Highway Department would have the authority to prohibit construction of billiboards and to take down those that fail to meet state specifications. The specifications are that signs would have to be at least 500 feet away from expressways, at least 300 feet from main highways in non-urban areas, and a. least 100 feet from roads in incorporated areas.
