**WATCHERS OF THE SKY**  
Night and day, at lonely outposts in northern Michigan, thousands of air spotters voluntarily undergo hardship and loss of sleep to protect our industrial areas from bombing raids.  
They rarely get into the headlines. Often they watch patiently through the hours without seeing or hearing a plane. But the day they faithfully perform is vital. In case of air attack it will be their trained eyes and ears that detect the approach of Axis bombers.  
A telephone stands ready in every spotter's post. With the words "Army Flash" the spotter gets an immediate connection with the nearest army information center. And if the aircraft reports cannot be identified as friendly, fighter planes roar into the air at once to intercept the enemy. At the same time all Civilian Defense headquarters are alerted and are warned by telephone to prepare for a raid.  
Citizens of Michigan who sleep soundly in their beds at home owe a debt of gratitude to the Aircraft Warning Service.

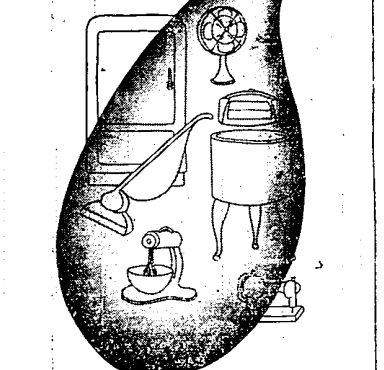
