

Cook Candy For Your Valentine

Old fashioned sentiment never goes out of style. And one of the sweetest ways of expressing it is with a gift of home-made candies.

Candy-making is much easier than it used to be for modern recipes are precise and surefire. Corn syrup helps to prevent the formation of unwanted crystals in cooked candies.

For Valentine's Day gift giving, make several varieties of candy. Begin by making large red hard candy hearts. Decorate each with a lacy looking edge made by writing with icing forced through a decorator's tube.

No gift of candy is complete without a fudge. A good, not too sweet one, is made with dairy sour cream. Include squares of fudge, a chewy peanut butter candy and easy-to-make Nutty Mocha Balls in your gift assortment.

CANDY HEARTS

- 1 c. sugar
- 1/2 c. light corn syrup
- 1/4 c. water
- Corn oil
- 1/4 t. peppermint extract (optional)

Red food coloring

Mix together sugar, corn syrup and water in saucepan. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly until mixture boils and sugar is dissolved. Boil without stirring, until temperature reaches 295 degrees F. or until small amount of mixture dropped into very cold water separates into threads which are hard. Meanwhile, grease two baking sheets with corn oil. Remove syrup from heat and stir in extract and food coloring. Arrange 12 greased heart shaped cutters on greased baking sheets. Pour hot candy mixture immediately into molds to depth of 1/4 - 1/2 inch. Remove cutters when candy is hard. Decorate with confectioners sugar frosting. Makes about 12 candy hearts.

CRUNCHY CHEWS

- 2/3 c. dark corn syrup
- 2 c. sugar
- 2/4 c. creamy or chunk style peanut butter
- 2/4 c. salted mixed nuts or peanuts, broken
- 1/2 c. corn flakes

Mix corn syrup and sugar in large saucepan. Bring to full boil, stirring constantly. Remove from heat. Quickly stir in peanut butter. Add mixed nuts or peanuts and cereal, stirring to coat evenly. Turn into greased (13 1/2 x 9 x 2 - inch) pan. Cool. Cut into squares. Makes 4 1/2 dozen (1 1/2 - inch) squares.

SOUR CREAM FUDGE

- 2 c. sugar
- 1/3 c. light corn syrup
- 1/3 c. dairy sour cream
- 2 T. margarine
- 1/4 t. salt
- 1 t. almond extract
- 1 c. coarsely chopped pecans
- 1 c. candied cherry halves

Grease 8x8x2 - inch pan. Mix together sugar, corn syrup, sour cream, margarine and salt in three quart saucepan. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until mixture comes to boil. Cover and cook one minute. Remove cover. Boil, without stirring, over medium heat until mixture reaches 295 degrees F. or until syrup when dropped into very cold water, forms a soft ball which flattens on removal from water. Remove from heat and let stand 15 minutes. Add extract and beat until mixture begins to lose its gloss, about five minutes. Stir in nuts and cherries; turn into prepared pan. Cool, cut into 36 pieces.

NUTTY MOCHA BALLS

6 (1-ounce) squares semi-sweet chocolate
1/4 c. light corn syrup
2 c. confectioners sugar
2 T. instant coffee powder
1/2 c. hot milk
1 t. vanilla
1 2/3 c. graham cracker crumbs
1 c. chopped walnuts
Finely chopped
Melt chocolate over hot water. Remove from heat. Add corn syrup and sugar, mixing well. Stir - coffee powder into milk and stir into chocolate mixture. Add vanilla, cracker crumbs and walnuts, mixing well. Chill about one hour or until firm enough to handle. Roll into one inch balls. Roll balls in finely chopped walnuts. Cover and store in refrigerator. Makes about 40 balls.
