MANILA—This Jap-made picture smuggled to the United States supposedly shows Filipino youths (center, uniforms) preparing to sail from Manila for Japan to take up studies fitting them as future leaders in their homeland. In the foreground, Filipino girls wave Japanese flags. According to the Japanese caption, the youths represent some of the leading families of the Philippines. The photo was brought out of the Japanese-occupied territory by Raymond P. Cronin, an American newspaperman who was interned at Manila and is now enroute to the U.S. aboard the exchange ship Gripsholm.
