The Aleutian Area
December 10, 1943

Dear Friends:
I have received many letters from home asking me how come that every one else in the service from Farmington can write home and tell where he is at and all about the Theatre of War in which he or she is located.

Well, as everyone knows by reading the papers and keeping up with the war news on the radio, we are now in full control of the Aleutian Area.

And that all the Japs that were once so well dug in and had such a good foothold on this area, have been either killed off or else so badly beaten that they have retreated to their home land which is not so far from here.

Therefore this area is one of the greatest threats to the northern end of Japan's homeland, and the best way to keep it that way is to keep a strict censorship on all military services.

Our censorship has eased up some as we can now say that we are in the Aleutian area, and also are able to send home a few snapshots or pictures that do not pertain to anything that might fall into the hands of the enemy and do them a lot of good. All of our pictures must pass through the censorship office and be stamped before mailing them home.

Our living conditions here are getting better all the time, with lots of good eats and for our Thanksgiving dinner we had a good feast on turkey and it sounds like we will have the same for our Christmas dinner.

For our own amusement here we have all kinds of movie shows.

In fact you can see a show at most any time you have a few hours to yourself.

Our theatre runs from early morning until late at night, with a change in picture every other day. And once a week we have a show in our mess hall.

Right now we have a show from the U.S.O. in which actors are Errol Flynn, Martha O. Driscoll, Jimmie Dods, and Ruth Carroll, so you see for our entertainment we don't do so bad.

And now at this time of year, I want to wish each and everyone of my friends and relatives at home, a Merry Christmas and best wishes for the coming New Year. Thanks for everything.

I wish to thank you for the paper. I always look forward to it arriving. It always has plenty of news about what's cooking around the old home town.


I was home on furlough in November and the town looks about the same except for quite a few missing faces. So keep it the same until we all get home again, which will be soon, I hope.
