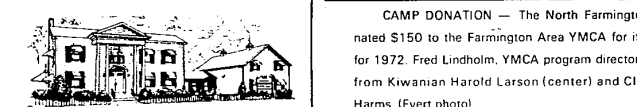
**WOMEN'S HEALTH CLUB**
