

Arts Council Offers Course

The Farmington Community Arts Council, in conjunction with the adult education department of the Farmington Schools, is sponsoring a course entitled "Exposure to the Arts." It will be held in Farmington Senior High School, 32000 Shawnee.

The course will begin March 21, and will run for eight Tuesday evenings. Each evening will be devoted to a different medium. The course is designed to acquaint people with all phases of the arts through lectures, demonstrations, films and slides.

THERE IS a charge of \$11. Farmington residents may be registered by phone. Non-residents are invited to register between 7 and 9 p.m., Monday, March 6, in the west auditorium of the high school.

John Glick will be the speaker at the first meeting. Glick will discuss pottery and the role of the full-time professional craftsman.

Glick opened his Plum Tree Pottery in 1964. He received his BFA from Wayne State University and his MFA from Cranbrook's Academy of Art. Besides having pieces in many major collections, he has been a popular exhibitor and has been guest lecturer at the Sheridan School of Design and the Chicago Institute of Art.

Hal Whiting, a residential and commercial architect, will be the speaker on March 28. He is a graduate of the Carnegie Institute of Technology.

Les Martens, host of the Detroit Symphony broadcasts on WWJ, will head the com-

munications section April 11. He will discuss broadcasting, music critics and recordings.

THE DISCUSSION of music will continue April 18 with Ted Mann as the speaker. Mann has had extensive experience in performing and composing. He has studied at the Eastman School of Music, Rochester, N.Y., and San Francisco State College.

Evelyn Kreson, director of the Suburban Concert Ballet, will bring her troupe April 25 for a discussion and demonstration on dance.

Photography will be the subject of Joe Clark's talk May 2. Clark is known nationally as the "Hibbilly Sharp Shooter."

June Brown, a feature writer, will discuss creative writing on May 9.
