

Art Classes Accent Young Creations

BLOOMFIELD HILLS
Young creations—macrame belts and neckbands, ceramic pots and printed and tie-dye fabrics—are among the “in” designs by young people in Cranbrook Academy of Art studio classes.
A 10 week term, beginning March 6 and ending May 27, is scheduled for young people and adults in the Academy of Art Galleries, 500 Lone Pine Road.
Young people’s art classes are open to children six to 19 years old and meet either week days 4 to 5:30 p.m. or at varied times Saturdays, according to age. Fee is \$35 which includes basic materials.
PARTICIPANTS MAY choose from a wide range of crafts: batik and tie-dye, drawing and painting, fabric printing, life drawing, macrame and sculptural crochet, ceramics, etching and engraving and basic art skills.
All adult classes meet

weekly from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m.
No previous artistic experience is necessary for enrollment. Fee is \$35 plus cost of materials.
Available to adults are etching and engraving or silk screen on Mondays, drawing and painting on both Tuesdays and Thursdays, and macrame and sculptural crochet on Wednesdays.
CLASSES are taught by academy students who are experienced in teaching.
“To afford optimum individual instruction to all students, class enrollment is limited to 15,” says director John Peterson. “Teaching assistants in the young people’s classes provide even more demonstration and individual attention.”
In addition to the art classes, the Galleries Community Activities Center also includes adult guided and free guided student tours, a children’s museum and a film library.

The center also offers gourmet cooking, sewing, woodworking, simple mechanics, leathercraft, guitar, photography, chess, and speed reading.

State Adds 26 Acres To Park

A 26-acre tract at the new Maybury State Park will be purchased for the development of recreational facilities, according to Sen. Carl Pursell (R-Plymouth).
The tract is part of the 865-acre park which was formerly the Maybury Sanatorium.
“Purchase of the site, which fronts for 600 feet along Seven Mile Rd. and extends more than 1,800 feet deep, will save the area from a previously planned subdivision development,” Pursell said.
The purchase was authorized by the Dept. of Natural Resources. The parcel will cost \$110,000 from the recreation bond program appropriated by the legislature last year for land acquisition.
