

# Things Done Hardly Enough

While rummaging through the files looking for something else, an editorial fell out written two years ago stating that it would require something close to super efforts by the community to curb the growth of drug abuse.

Two years ago the Rap Line program was being operated in North Farmington Baptist Church, and the city, township and schools had not yet joined to sponsor the Farmington Area Advisory Council.

**THE MESSAGE** editorially was that drug abuse was a symptom of a greater problem

which required community attention. That greater problem was what was and should be available to occupy the leisure time of youth.

The challenge given in this was that the community needed to have guts enough to ask youth what recreation facilities are desired and then seek means of providing them.

In my opinion, that challenge remains unmet. The FAAC has been organized but the larger issue of recreation for youth is unresolved.

Jack Mingo recently talked about that unfilled gap in a Dissent column on the editorial page of this newspaper. Mingo quite distinctly expressed why kids might turn to drugs. Yet, there has been little response from the community.

**THE FACT** there has been little response does not mean the community is callous or cannot recognize the need. Like other problems, this

one will require expenditures of money and planning which go beyond the traditional government agencies.

The planning must involve youth as advisors, and governments rarely listen to youth. The idea of youth advisors turns out politicians because it is generally assumed only adults know how to best spend money, even if the money is to be spent on youth.

There have been steps taken to improve recreation in the Farmington area. One is the proposed Walden Park in Farmington Township. This is a great thing and long overdue, but the excited townshippers must remember that the park will be limited in providing recreation for teens.

The Farmington Area YMCA is constructing a center which could be used by teens, but the majority of YMCA participants are early teens and under.

The Community Center continues to expand its

programs, but the Center is not intended to meet the recreation needs of youth and its offerings are understandably limited.

The drop - in centers organized this past summer were an important beginning but only a beginning toward ten programs. The proposed employment service is commendable but answers only a part of the problem.

**TO ARGUE** that all these programs combined adequately meets the challenge is a poor argument. Seldom is a smattering of programs equal to A Program.
